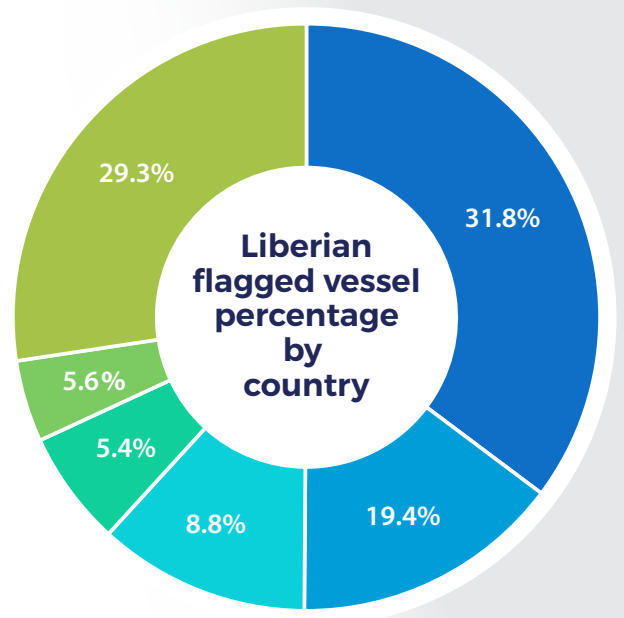

The Liberian Registry has a fleet of more than 5,900 ships of more than 262 million gross tons, representing 16.11 percent of the world's ocean-going fleet.

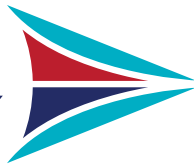
Due to the highest level of experience and technical background of its staff, Liberia traditionally has been considered one of the top choices for bulk carrier owners.

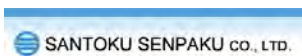
The Liberian Advantage:
