Subject: Alert (02) 2022 - Security WARNING IN / OFF GABON / OFF CAMEROON / OFF EQUATORIAL GUINEA / OFF SAO TOME AND PRINCIPE / GULF OF GUINEA

11 February, 2022

This email is to inform you about a report received from IMB Piracy Reporting Center regarding increase threat of piracy attacks against Shipping Offshore within the areas of the following coordinates 0315N 00610E, 0315N 00840E, 0140N 00840E, 0140N 00610E. The General area is therefore considered high risk. All mariners and vessels transiting in the demarcated area are advised to be extra vigilant, and if possible, make arrangements for escort services. Any suspicious activities should be reported to the MDAT- GoG which is the point of contact in the event of any incident in Gulf of Guinea.

Other areas in the Gulf of Guinea also remain risky and same measures should be applied when transiting the region.

This warning remains valid for the next few days, however, pirates may drift longer periods.

Vessels should exercise extreme caution and remain vigilant, maintain strict anti-piracy watch and measures.

In case of an attack, attempted attack or suspected attack, vessels should activate their SSAS, and immediately contact the Regional Maritime Rescue Coordination Centre (RMRCC) in Lagos:

Shipowners/Operators/Masters of Liberian flagged vessels are strongly encouraged to participate in the MDAT Voluntary Reporting Scheme to improve regional domain awareness and information sharing and allow relevant authorities to be informed of an incident in a timely manner. Masters of vessels are advised to provide an "Initial Report" to MDAT-GoG when entering the affected area defined Security Chart Q6114 or leaving a port within this area and report daily while operating within the established area; and to submit a final report when leaving the defined area.
