General Requirements for Exam/Exam Renewal

- 1. State the reason why the applicant cannot obtain a national license.
- 2. Submit a copy of the letter from the employer stating that applicant will be employed on a Liberian flagged vessel.
- 3. The application must be submitted by your employer (valid Liberian filing agent).

Exam applications must include the following:

- Copy of company letter;
- Physical completed within one year of when the application is submitted;
- Copy of passport;
- List of Sea Service;
- 2 passport-sized photos; and
- · Copies of the below-listed certificates.

Please note, if any of these items are missing from the exam application it will be rejected.
